Through their donations, the GBG India team provided a water purifier, blankets, electric rice cooker, stove, books, groceries and individual gifts to the children.

To celebrate, the staff held a holiday party in honor of the children. After a full meal, a GBG staff member dressed as Santa passed out gifts for the children.
